ENTREPRENEURSHIP AND RURAL DEVELOPMENT CONCLAVE (ERDC – 2019)

During the conclave held from 17-19 December, 2019, the institute organized three one day Conferences as follows:

During a one day Conference on the "Need of Entrepreneurship Development" especially for the School Principals of Northern Region on 17.12.2019 at NITTTR, Sector-26, Chandigarh, Shri Rattan Lal Kataria, Hon'ble Minister of State, Jal Shakti, Social Justice and Empowerment, Government of India, the Chief Guest, in his address emphasized on the need for entrepreneurship development at the initial stages, i.e., from the school level so that the students can be groomed for becoming entrepreneurs at a later stage. Shri Nayab Singh Saini, Hon'ble MP Lok Sabha, Kurukshetra, the Guest of Honor, harped upon Youth Empowerment by developing skills. Sh. Mukul Kanitkar, a Social Reformer and the Guest of Honor, focused on the enriched history of India with respect to literacy and economic development. Professor Raj Kumar, Vice Chancellor, Panjab



University, Chandigarh focused on Innovation & Research and highlighted the importance of rural entrepreneurship. Professor SK Das, Director, IIT, Ropar highlighted the glorious past of the country & exhorted the youth to invade the world with brilliant ideas and philosophy. Professor SS Pattnaik, Director, NITTTR, Chandigarh spoke of building Partnership & Networking and highlighted the importance of entrepreneurs in a Nation's economy Professor SK Dhameja, Conference Coordinator highlighted about 5 technical sessions, viz., Blue Ocean Strategy for Entrepreneurship Promotion; Innovation for Entrepreneurship Promotion in Schools; Generation of Eco-System for Entrepreneurship at Schools; Interaction with an Entrepreneur; and Three Phased Entrepreneurship Development Programme. The program is an intensive training program covering the requirements of International Standard ISO 17025:2017 for the management system of testing and calibration laboratories establishing a quality management system and technical competence in its particular field of testing/calibration. Compliance with this standard is mandatory for laboratories seeking accreditation from National Accreditation Board for Laboratories (NABL) in India or any other accreditation body worldwide. The program

was coordinated by Er. Himmi Gupta, Assistant Professor and Dr. Sanjay Sharma, Incharge, Center for Clean Technologies & Sustainable Development and was attended by 15 participants from various governments organizations and private laboratories.
