#### Message from Professor SS Pattnaik, Director

## International Conference on Edge, IOT and Social Computing for Digital Villages


An "International Conference on Edge, IoT and Social Computing for Digital Villages" organized by the Department of Computer Science & Engg., NITTTR, Chandigarh during April 29-30, 2021 sponsored by AICTE, New Delhi. The conference was jointly inaugurated by Prof. (Dr.) SS Pattnaik, Director, NITTTR Chandigarh and Prof. (Dr.) Raj Kumar Buyya, Professor and Director of CLOUDS Lab, School of Computing & Information Systems, the University of Melbourne, Australia. The conference hosted keynote addresses by International Speakers Dr. Gabriella Casalino, CILAB Laboratory, Department of Computer Science University of Bari "Aldo Moro", Italy and Prof. Shiv Kumar Mathapathi, Adjunct



Faculty, Santa Clara University, and UC San Diego Extension, Co-founder of Dew Mobility, USA. 135 participants attended the seminar and 27 participants (researchers and academicians from all over India) presented papers in the conference. The International Conference provided an exposure to the recent advancements and innovations that can be used for enriching digital villages.

#### **Observance of Anti-Terrorism Day on 21st May, 2021:**

The Antiterrorism day was celebrated on 21st may, 2021 in the institute by conducting Reading of Pledge in online mode following the guidelines issued in the wake of COVID 19 pandemic. ## **Celebration of International Yoga Day**

- 2. Preparation of Instructional Video: A Video programme, as per guidelines of Yoga Protocol including demonstration of Yoga Asanas and Pranayam techniques was prepared. Dr.Baban Kumar, Senior Principal Scientist was invited as the guest expert.
- 3. Conduct of Yoga Practice session: The session was conducted from 6.30 am to 7.45 am on June 21,2021 with the help of video.
- 4. Distribution of Yoga Mats: Yoga Mats were made available to occupants of Girls Hostel for personal use due to prevailing conditions to encourage and facilitate Yoga activities.



RT-PCR Testing Camps were organized for COVID-19 at the Institute in collaboration with the Chandigarh Administration on May 27, 2021 and June 2021 from 10:00 AM to 1:00 PM for the Institute faculty, staff (including contractual and mess/canteen staff members and workers), students and their family members. Samples of about 155 faculty & staff and their family members and 120 students were collected by a team of doctors for RT-PCR Testing.



## **Support System/Infrastructure Development**

Advanced laboratory for Cyber Security was set up in the Department of Information Management and Emerging Engineering, NITTTR under the sponsored project funded by Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology, Government of India and was Inaugurated by Shri Madhu Ranjan Kumar Joint Secretary (Administration) Ministry of Education (Department of Higher Education) Government of Indian presence of Prof.(Dr.) SS Pattnaik, Director and Member of BOGs and Principal Investigator Prof. (Dr.) Maitreyee Dutta through online mode. The advanced cyber security laboratory contains high end computer Systems and Hardware Equipment like True Imager, Write Blocker, Win-Lift, Cyber Check suite and many more. More than 25 Lab Manuals were developed by Team Members under the project "Establishment of Advanced laboratory for Cyber Security Training to technical teachers" on open source and commercial tools of cyber security and cyber forensics and numerous video lectures were also recorded which are available in NCTEL web portal to share with participants if required.

A meeting of the Board of Governors of the institute took place on June 18, 2021 in physical as well as video conference medium. This was 54th meeting during which 11 BoG members attended

# **R&D/Consultancy Activities**

The institute received an amount of Rs. 63,36,418/- in various Consultancy Projects as detailed below:

- a) Rs. 8,83,820/- was received by CDC Department against project from Aarav Educational & Employment Research Organization (AEERO), Delhi for designing NSQF aligned 10 courses.
- b) Rs. 31,86,000/- was received by CDC Department against project from HSBTE, Panchkula for developing/designing NSQF compliant 27 Curricula as per NSQF/NEP 2020/AICTE.
- c) Rs. 22,66,598/- was received by Civil Engineering Department in a Consultancy Project.

## **Sponsored Project:**

4 AICTE-ATAL Programmes have been approved by AICTE, out of which 1 AICTE-ATAL Programme on `Cyber Security Vulnerabilities and Safeguards' was conducted during 17–21 May, 2021. A total of 176 participants were trained and a grant of Rs.93,000/-was received.
