### 49 Years Of Dedicated Service To Nation

7<sup>th</sup> September, 2016 was a momentous occasion when the institute celebrated its 49<sup>th</sup> Annual Day with vigour and enthusiasm. Prof. Sarit K. Das, Director, IIT Ropar, was the Chief Guest and Prof. MPS Ishar, Vice-Chancellor, MRSPTU, Bathinda, distinguished Guest; Padma Bhushan Dr. K.K. Talwar, Chairman, Board of Governors, NITTTR, Chandigarh was the Presiding Guest and Prof. Kannan Moudgalya IIT, Bombay was the Guest of Honour at the event.

Dr. MP Poonia, Director of the Institute highlighted the achievements of the institute during 2015-16 and the other new initiatives like Setting up of New Laboratories: Flexible Manufacturing Systems, Cisco Academy and Networking and Upgradation of Laboratories: Development of NITTTR'S Android App and Software for Accounts and MIS for Community Development Through Polytechnics Scheme (CDTP); Designing of Curriculum for Certificate Courses for MRSSTU, Bathinda, increase of Internet Bandwidth of the institution from 100 Mbps to I Gbps by National Knowledge Network (NKN). Two Start-ups named Flip Flop Pvt Ltd. and Enovate Skill have been started at NITTTR Premises. At the international level, the institute has also contributed by developing 100 educational video films for the teachers and students of Lagos Skipper Engineering Academy (LSEA), Ikotun, Nigeria in Electrical Installation & Maintenance Work and study material for Technical School in Nigeria. Chandigarh is selected as one of the fifteen Mentoring Institutes for Unnat Bharat Abhiyan initiated by MHRD, Govt. of India.

During the year, the institute Signed 07 MoUs with prestigious organizations prominent among them being: Desh Bhagat University Mandi Gobindgarh (Punjab); IIT, Bombay; Biju Patnaik University of Technology, Odisha; IBM India Private Limited, Bangalore; Cleantech International Foundation, New Delhi; Lovely Professional University, Phagwara (Punjab); Maharaja Ranjit Singh State Technical University, Bathinda (Punjab); HP University, Shimla and Skippers Electrical India Limited.

The institute is planning to use 50% Power through Solar Energy for which 10 solar lights, 35 kWP Solar Panels and Solar Water Heating in hostels and residences are already installed.


