MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN

NATIONAL INSTITUTE OF TECHNICAL TEACHERS TRAINING AND RESEARCH (NITTTR), CHANDIGARH AND

KHALSA COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING AND TECHNOLOGY, AMRITSAR (PUNJAR)

PREAMBLE

National Institute of Technical Teachers Training and Research, Chandigarh (hereinafter referred to as NITTTR, Chandigarh) was established in the year 1967 by Ministry of Education, Government of India with several objectives viz. training teachers of polytechnics and Engineering Colleges through different types of courses, fostering and promoting research in improving classroom and laboratory instruction, preparing and supplying teaching aids and instructional materials, associating with other academic bodies of technical education to achieve quality improvement in academic programmes, collaborating with institutions and organisations in India and abroad having similar objectives and functions, and interacting with industries in formulating training programmes and undertaking projects of mutual interest.

Khalsa College of Engineering and Technology, Amritsar (herein referred to as KCET) approved by AICTE and affiliated to I.K. Gujral Punjab Technical University is a progressive institution in Punjab, set up to promote the highest standards of technical education in the state. Khalsa College of Engineering and Technology, Amritsar is accredited by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), Bangalore with Grade 'A'. KCET is part of the prestigious Khalsa College Charitable Society Amritsar, established in 1892 under Societies Registration Act XXI of 1860 as a non-profitable, non-commercial, charitable society. It offers Graduate and Post Graduate programmes in various disciplines of Engineering & Technology, Management and Paramedical Science. The institution aims to develop manpower that will meet the requirements of the world of work by developing necessary competencies in them through the education. The main activities of the KCET are as follows

- To undertake graduate (degree) programme in different fields of engineering, Management, and paramedical Science.
- To undertake post-graduate program in paramedical Science.

Recognizing the need to provide adequately and appropriately trained technical manpower to meet the growing needs of industries and institutions, NITTTR, Chandigarh and KCET, Amritsar agree to collaborate/co-ordinate with each other with a view to enriching the quality of the technical education and training in the state of Punjab. Both the organizations propose to conduct educational and training programmes with active assistance and collaboration with industry and institutes of higher learning.

NITTTR, Chandigarh and KCET, Amritsar accordingly enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) as given below.

2. AGREEMENT

Accordingly, NITTTR, Chandigarh and KCET, Amritsar hereby agree to work jointly in conducting training programmes and other academic activities such as development of instructional material, R&D and Consultancy projects for:

- (i) Faculty of Engineering/Polytechnics Colleges and other technical supporting staff.
- (ii) Officers/Officials of the Department /Board of Technical Education, Punjab.

COMMITMENT BY NITTTR, CHANDIGARH

- 3.1 In order to promote technical teacher training requirements at national level NITTTR, Chandigarh will work jointly with KCET, Amritsar to organize the programmes and activities, in accordance with the stipulation of the scope and nature of collaboration as stated under 2 of the forgoing section.
- 3.2 NITTTR, Chandigarh will be responsible for organizing academic activities including providing resource faculty for the training programmes, dissemination of instructional material and general conduct of the programmes, which would be jointly identified from time to time.
- 3.3 NITTTR, Chandigarh will bear the cost of TA/DA to participants of Government/Government Aided Engineering/Polytechnics Colleges for attending education and training programmes organized by it.
- 3.4 NITTTR, Chandigarh will provide working lunch and tea to participants from private colleges/institutions. No TA/DA is admissible to them.
- 3.5 NITTTR, Chandigarh will also bear all other relevant expenditure, if any, subject to the rules and regulations of Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India, imposed from time to time, as applicable to NITTTR, Chandigarh.

- 3.6 NITTTR will bear the cost of TA/DA and honorarium to the experts that may be invited during the conduct of the programmes.
- 3.7 NITTTR shall provide honorarium to the local coordinator and ancillary staff as per its prevailing norms.
- 3.8 NITTTR, Chandigarh will facilitate the college faculty for undergoing Pedagogical Training through NITTTR guidelines.

Note: The above provision may change from time to time, as per the rules/norms approved by BOG/MOE/institute from time to time

4. COMMITMENT BY KCET, AMRITSAR

- 4.1 KCET, Amritsar will take initiatives to facilitate participation by faculty/teachers from Government/Government aided engineering colleges and polytechnics of the state.
- 4.2 KCET, Amritsar will promote participation of all technical teachers in new/emerging technology areas.
- 4.3 KCET, Amritsar shall provide the guest house facility for Experts/NITTTR faculty and officials free of cost/or on nominal charges.
- 4.4 KCET, Amritsar shall provide necessary infrastructure facilities e.g., classroom, conference hall, laboratories, library etc. that may be necessary for conduct of the programme and other activities free of cost.
- 4.5 KCET, Amritsar shall provide the hostel and mess/canteen facilities for outstation participants at nominal rates.

5. TENURE OF THE MOU:

The said MOU shall be valid for a period of 3 years from the date of agreement and can be further extended for an equal or a different period on mutual consent. In case of any difference of opinion that may arise during the execution of this MOU in its true spirit, both parties shall make genuine efforts to resolve the same by mutual talks. In case the same persists, either of the party can terminate the MOU by giving a notice of 30 days.

6. FORCE MAJEURE

Notwithstanding any item contained in this MoU, neither party shall be held responsible for actions beyond their control (e.g. natural calamities, law & order situation and so on) and no compensation shall be claimed by either party from other nor shall it be paid. Either party may terminate this MoU in the event a force majeure event subsists for more than thirty (30) days.

OPERATIONAL MECHANISM

- 7.1 All communication shall be addressed to the head of the respective institutions who may authorize any senior officials to do so on their behalf.
- 7.2 Head of the respective institutions shall be authorized to make decision on behalf of their institutions unless otherwise the execution powers are delegated to any senior official(s).

This memorandum shall be deemed as pledge and a statement of intent to foster genuine, workable and mutually beneficial professional collaboration for the socio-economic development of the country in general and the state of Punjab in particular.
