At the outset, Dr SC Laroiya, Director & Member Secretary extended warm welcome to all the members of the committee and conveyed them his thanks for sparing their valuable time to attend the meeting, despite their busy schedule.

Thereafter Shri Yashpal Mahajan, after conveying his thanks to the Member Secretary also extended hearty welcome to all the members of the Committee and requested Dr SC Laroiya, Director and Member Secretary of the Committee to conduct the proceedings of the meeting. Thereafter various agenda items were deliberated as under:

TO CONFIRM THE MINUTES OF THE 9<sup>TH</sup> MEETING OF FINANCE COMMITTEE HELD ON 16-10-2007 AND TO REPORT ACTION TAKEN THEREON.

The minutes of the 9<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Finance Committee of the institute held on 16-10-2007 were confirmed as recorded.

TO CONSIDER DECLARATION OF GOODS INCLUDING EQUIPMENT, FURNITURE ETC. AS OBSOLETE OR UNSERVICEABLE.

The committee recommended that the goods including equipment and furniture items costing Rs 59,79,472.52 as indicated in the agenda item be declared as unserviceable/obsolete and disposed of by way of public auction/sealed bids and the sale proceeds thereof be deposited in the institute accounts, as per provisions of the General Financial Rules.

TO REPORT PROGRESS OF EXPENDITURE AGAINST GRANTS-IN-AID RECEIVED FROM THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT.

The committee recommended that the funds allocated to the institute both under plan and non plan for the current financial year be spent as per rules in the institute's interest so that there is neither any deficit nor any surplus at the close of the year. The institute should plan accordingly.

TO CONSIDER GRANT OF BENEFIT UNDER ASSURED CAREER PROGRESSION SCHEME TO THOSE INSTITUTE EMPLOYEES WHO WERE ALLOWED ONLY ONE FINANCIAL UPGRADATION UNDER RETRAINING AND REDEPLOYMENT SCHEME/ONE REGULAR PROMOTION.

The committee recommended that the proposal seems prima-facie in order. However, it should be resubmitted in the next meeting with complete information of the employees facing hardship along with a copy of the Retraining and Redeployment Scheme.

ITEM No.F.10.5 TO CONSIDER ENHANCEMENT OF FEE OF THE INSTITUTE COUNSELS.

The committee recommended that the fee payable to the Institute Counsels for contesting court cases on behalf of the institute be revised as under:

For High Court Cases	Rs 10,000/- + Rs 1000/- as clerkage and contingent expenses.
For Lower Court Cases	Rs 5000/- + Rs 500/- as clerkage and contingent expenses.

TO CONSIDER STEPPING UP OF PAY OF SHRI TARA CHAND, LABORATORY ATTENDANT.

The committee recommended that as the case has already been considered by the Ministry therefore a fresh case with new facts, if any, be again referred to the Ministry for consideration.

SUPPLEMENTARY ITEM No.F.10.7

TO CONSIDER ADDITIONAL GRANT UNDER PLAN FOR CONSTRUCTION OF NEW HOSTEL BLOCK AND ADDITIONAL LECTURE HALL COMPLEX AT NITTTR, SECTOR 26, CHANDIGARH.

The committee recommended that the Ministry may be requested to release sufficient funds for the project within the already approved budget estimates of the institute so that construction work by the CPWD may start.
