The report does not contain copy of audit certificate as the same has not yet been received from the Audit Office though the audit of the institute accounts was conducted by the Principal Accountant General (Audit) Punjab & U.T. Chandigarh from 3 – 14 July, 2009. The matter is being pursued. In case the certificate is received from the Audit Office by the time of meeting, then the same will be placed before the Board of Governors at the time of meeting, otherwise the same will be incorporated in the Annual Report before its submission to the Ministry for its placement in the Parliament.

These posts could not be filled due to imposition of ban imposed by the Govt. of India on recruitment against vacant non-faculty posts until the ratio between faculty and non-faculty comes to 1:1.1. Though the institute aims to achieve the fixed target ratio of faculty and non-faculty posts to 1:1.1, yet it is not in the interest of the institute to keep the above noted essential vacant posts without which the affairs of the institute cannot be managed properly.

The institute may, therefore, be allowed to fill up the above-mentioned essential sanctioned posts by relaxing the stipulated ratio of 1:1.1.

Moreover, in the recent past, the activities of the institute have increased many-fold due to enlargement of the objectives of the institute and raising of its status from a regional to a national institute. Besides, the requirement of staff has also increased due to implementation of reservation policy of the Government of India for OBCs. The institute is facing acute shortage of staff because it has already abolished 60 sanctioned posts and other 16 posts are lying vacant. All the above said posts are urgently required for the smooth functioning of the institute. These can also not be outsourced.

The Board of Governors may consider and recommend to the Ministry for granting permission to fill up these posts.

THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS MAY CONSIDER AND APPROVE.

ITEM No. B.15.4.4 TO CONSIDER FILLING UP OF VACANT FACULTY POSTS ON CONTRACT BASIS

There are twenty sanctioned posts of faculty which are lying vacant in the institute. It includes ten posts of Professors, two posts of Assistant Professors and eight posts of Lecturers. Though all these posts were advertised by the institute once or twice, the recruitment could not be done due to certain administrative reasons e.g. for want of a regular Director, expiry of the term of Chairman, Board of Governors, notification of revised pay scales of faculty and the like. New guidelines regarding qualification and experience etc for recruitment of faculty after the notification of new pay scales by Ministry of Human Resource Development are awaited from the MHRD/AICTE. After the guidelines are received, recruitment rules of the institute will be amended accordingly. This process is likely to take quite some time. However, due to acute shortage of faculty in the institute, the academic work of the institute is suffering greatly. It is proposed that some

vacant posts may be filled as per existing recruitment rules on contract basis through walk-in-interview. It is also proposed that two Project Associates may be engaged against one vacant post of faculty on consolidated remuneration basis. This arrangement will ease the position, at least for some time. However, the institute will continue to make all out efforts to fill up all the vacant posts on regular basis as early as possible.

THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS MAY CONSIDER THE PROPOSAL AND APPROVE.

ITEM NO.B.15.4.5 TO CONSIDER THE REQUEST OF DR. PARIJAT DE, DIRECTOR FOR PERMISSION TO STAY IN THE INSTITUTE GUEST HOUSE UNTIL HE SHIFTS TO THE DIRECTOR'S LODGE.

Dr. Parijat De, Director, has requested vide his letter dated 06.07.2009, copy attached as **Annexure-VIII** at page No.87, that since his family has been staying at Kolkata, in a Government quarter, therefore, he cannot shift to the Director's Lodge in the institute campus and he may be allowed to stay in the institute guest house for a period of one year or so till his family joins him at Chandigarh and he shifts to the Director's Lodge. He has also given his consent that during his stay in the institute guest house he will not draw House Rent Allowance and also pay license fee as applicable for Director's Lodge.

Professor-in-Charge guest house has recommended that Dr.Parijat De may be allowed to enjoy the facility of institute guest house without any additional charge, since Dr.Parijat De will not be claiming House Rent Allowance during the period of his stay in the institute guest house. A copy of his recommendations is attached as **Annexure-IX** at page No.88.

It is also stated that Dr.Parijat De is entitled for House Rent Allowance @ 20% on his pay which comes approximately to Rs.15,000/- per month. The licence fee for Director's lodge is Rs.639/- per month. The charges for single occupancy in the institute guest house is, however, Rs.200/- per day i.e.

Rs.6,000/- per month. Thus, the rental charges of guest house are much lower than HRA's entitlement of Dr.Parijat De.

It is worthwhile mentioning here that the Director's Lodge in the institute campus which is meant for the residence of Director, has been lying vacant for the last about three years, because the Director's post was lying vacant during this period and the Acting Director did not occupy the house.

Board of Governors, may kindly consider the request of Dr.Parijat De to use the facility of a room in the institute guest house for one year or so during which period he will not draw house rent allowance and also pay license fee as applicable to Director's lodge. As regards the Director lodge, the same may be used for some other bonafide purposes of the institute during the above said period, if deemed fit.

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The availability of permanent posts for confirmation has already been de-linked by the institute on the basis of Government of India, Department of Personnel & Training's O.M. No.18011/1/86-Estt(D) dated 28.03.1998, with effect from 01.04.1998, with the approval of Board of Governors accorded in its 51st meeting held on 18.03.1989 vide item No.B.51.24, on the basis of recommendations of Finance & Personnel Committee vide item No.F.22.22.

In pursuance of the above noted decision of the Board of Governors, the faculty members who have completed their probation period successfully with other conditions for confirmation having been fulfilled, may be considered for confirmation.

All the above noted faculty members are satisfying the eligibility conditions for confirmation as per rules as all are educationally qualified for the posts in which they have been appointed, they also satisfy the age limit prescribed for respective posts and have been duly examined by the appropriate medical authority and found fit. There is nothing adverse against them. The Annual Confidential Reports as well as special reports from the respective Heads of Department regarding their work and conduct are also in order. No vigilance case too is either pending or contemplated against any one of them.

ITEM NO. B.15.4.7 TO CONSIDER AMENDMENT OF THE CONSTITUTION OF STANDING COMMITTEE FOR SPONSORSHIP OF INSTITUTE FACULTY TO INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCES AND TO DELEGATE POWERS TO THE DIRECTOR OF THE INSTITUTE TO CONSTITUTE THE STANDING COMMITTEE AND FOR FINAL APPROVAL.

The Board of Governors of the institute in its 54th meeting held on 15.02.1990 vide item No.B.54.15 had approved the criteria for sponsoring the institute faculty to present papers in the International Conferences and constituted a Standing Committee to examine and recommend such cases for sponsorship. The existing constitution of the Standing Committee, as approved by the Board of Governors, is as under:

ITEM NO.15.4.8 TO CONSIDER THE REVIEW OF EFFECTIVE DATE OF IMPLEMENTATION OF CAREER ADVANCEMENT SCHEME OF AICTE FOR PROMOTIONS OF INSTITUTE FACULTY ON IN-SITU BASIS.

The Government of India, Ministry of Human Resource Development vide their letter No.34-104/95-TS.II dated 09.10.1998 had issued the scheme of revision of pay scales of teachers in Centrally Funded Degree Level Technical Institutions following the revision of pay scales of Central Government employees on the recommendations of Fifth Central Pay Commission. The Scheme, interalia, provided career advancement for faculty through the selection process for which appropriate guidelines were required to be laid down by the AICTE in consultation with the Government of India. In pursuance thereof the AICTE issued the guidelines for Career Advancement Scheme vide their letter No. 1-65/CD/NEC/98-99 dated 31.07.2001. The said scheme was adopted by the institute with the approval of the Board of Governors accorded in its 90th meeting held on 25.09.2001 vide Item No.B.90.12. A copy of the resolution of the Board of Governors is attached as Annexure-X at page 89. Subsequently the Government, MHRD vide their letter No.F.35-2/99-TS.II dated 08.04.2002 clarified that the Career Advancement Scheme may be implemented only with the prospective date, i.e from the date of its announcement by the AICTE or the date from which the Governing Body of the institute approves its implementation whichever is later. A copy of the clarifications issued by the Ministry is attached as Annexure-XI at page 90-91. Accordingly the scheme was implemented in the institute from 25.09.2001 i.e the date from which the Governing Body of the Institute had approved its implementation in the institute. Later on, the Government of India, MHRD vide their DO No.7-19/2002-TS.IV dated 19.09.2002 directed that the effective date of benefit of Career Advancement Scheme to the incumbents should only be from a prospective date on which the Selection Committee meeting takes place. The

directions were reiterated vide Ministry's letter No. F.7-19/2002.TS.IV dated 29.10.2002. Copies of these letters are attached as **Annexure-XII** and **XII-A** respectively at page Nos.92 and 93. Accordingly the directions of the Ministry were followed and the beneficiaries of the Scheme were given the financial benefit and designation from the date of meeting of the Selection Committee from time to time. However the concerned faculty members have now requested that the benefit of Career Advancement Scheme be given to them from the date of issuance of guidelines by the AICTE i.e July 31, 2001 or from the date of their eligibility for promotion under this scheme, whichever is later.

A faculty member has also represented for implementation of the scheme from 01.01.1996 as per letter No.FD/PSSC/Clarif/2002/1dated 03.01.2003 of AICTE, copy enclosed as **Annexure XII-B** at page Nos.93(a) to 93(c).

THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS MAY CONSIDER AND DECIDE.

ITEM NO.15.4.9 TO CONSIDER THE REVIEW OF GRANT OF INCREMENTS TO ASSISTANT PROFESSORS OF THE INSTITUTE ON ACQUIRING Ph.D DEGREE.

The Government of India, Ministry of Human Resource Development, Department of Education vide their letter No.34-104/95-TS.II dated 09.10.1998 had issued the scheme of revision of pay scales of teachers in Centrally Funded Degree Level Technical Institutions following the revision of pay scales of Central Government employees on the recommendations of Fifth Central Pay Commission. The scheme, interalia, provided incentive for Ph.D both at the time of recruitment as well as during service to the teachers. The relevant clause of the original scheme reads as under:

(a) At the time of recruitment as Lecturers, four and two advance increments will be admissible those of the Science/Humanities faculty who hold Ph.D and M.Phil degrees respectively; and to

- those of the technical faculty who hold Ph.D and ME/M.Tech degree respectively.
- (b) One increment will be admissible to those Science/Humanities teachers with M.Phil and to those technical faculty with ME/M.Tech who acquire Ph.D within two years of recruitment.
- (c) A Lecturer with Ph.D will be eligible for two advance increments when he moves into Selection Grade as Assistant Professor.
- (d) A teacher will be eligible for two advance increments as and when the teacher acquires Ph.D degree in the service career (Clause was deleted subsequently).

The scheme was adopted by the institute with the approval of Board of Governors. Later on the Government of India, MHRD vide their letter No.F.No.7-13/2004-TS.IV dated 13.12.2004, copy attached as **Annexure-XIII** at page No.94-95, intimated that two advance increments on obtaining Ph.D degree are admissible for **Lecturer**. It was also categorically stated that advance increments are not applicable on acquiring Ph.D degree if a faculty has acquired Ph.D degree after becoming **Assistant Professor** through ACP where Ph.D is a part of the prescribed qualifications. The following clause was also **deleted** by AICTE as intimated vide above letter dated 13.12.2004:

A teacher will be eligible for two advance increments as and when the teacher acquires Ph.D degree in the service career, Clause 6.0(c) of AICTE notification 1-65/Cd/NEC/98-99 dated 15th March 2000 stands deleted.

It is worthwhile mentioning here that Ph.D is an essential qualification for the post of Assistant Professor and those who do not possess Ph.D at the time of promotion or appointment as Assistant Professor, they are required to complete Ph.D within a period of seven years from the date of their promotion or appointment as the case may be. This is as per AICTE guidelines which have been adopted by the institute. However the Assistant Professors of the

institute are demanding two advance increments on their acquiring Ph.D degree while they were working as Assistant Professors.

However, increments for Ph.D. are demanded by the Assistant Professors who are appointed by open selection before 01.01.1996 and Ph.D. was optional for them.

Copies of the representations made by the institute faculty in this regard are also attached as **Annexure-XIV** at Page Nos. 96 to 101.

BOARD OF GOVERNORS MAY CONSIDER AND DECIDE.

ITEM NO.F.15.4.10 TO CONSIDER ADOPTION / EXTENSION OF MODIFIED ASSURED CAREER PROGRESSION SCHEME TO THE ELIGIBLE EMPLOYEES OF THE INSTITUTE

The institute had adopted the Assured Career Progression Scheme 1999 of the Central Government for the non teaching employees of the institute. The said scheme remained in operation until August 31, 2008 i.e. until the date of introduction of the Modified Assured Career Progression Scheme 2008.

The Government of India, Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions (Department of Personnel and Training), New Delhi have notified the Modified Assured Career Progression Scheme (MACPS) for the Central Government Civilian employees vide Office Memorandum No.35034/3/2008-Estt(D) dated May 19, 2009, a copy of which is enclosed as Annexure-XV at page No. 102-111. This scheme is operational from 01.09.2008.

Para 14 of Annexure-I to the aforesaid Office Memorandum dated May 19, 2009 of the Department of Personnel and Training reads as under:

"The MACPS is directly applicable only to Central Government Civilian employees. It will not get automatically extended to employees of Central Autonomous / Statutory Bodies under the administrative control of a Ministry / Department. Keeping in view

the financial implications involved, a conscious decision in this regard shall have to be taken by the respective Governing Body/Board of Directors and the administrative Ministry concerned and where it is proposed to adopt the MACPS, prior concurrence of Ministry of Finance shall be obtained."

As the institute had been following the Assured Career Progression Scheme 1999, and there is no other promotional scheme available to the non teaching employees of the institute, therefore, it is proposed that the Modifies Assured Career Progression Scheme (MACPS) for the Central Government Civilian employees as amended from time to time, may be adopted and extended to the employees of the institute as per provisions of the scheme.

BOARD MAY CONSIDER TO ADOPT / EXTEND THE MODIFIED ASSURED CAREER PROGRESSION SCHEME (MACPS) TO THE ELIGIBLE EMPLOYEES OF THE INSTITUTE.

ITEM No. B.15.4.11TO CONSIDER AND APPROVE THE DESIGNATION OF MULTI SKILLED ATTENDANTS TO MULTI SKILLED EMPLOYEES.

In deference to the recommendations of the 6th Pay Commission, designations of all erstwhile Group 'D' employees were changed to Multi Skilled Attendants by getting it passed in a meeting of the Board of Governors. However, it was found later on that such former Group 'D' employees have been given the designation of Multi Skilled Employee in the Department of Posts of the Government of India vide its O.M.No.1-20 / 2008-PCC, dated 27.03.2009.

The concerned employees union of the institute has requested the administration to adopt the designation of Multi Skilled Employee/Multi Skilled Assistant instead of Multi Skilled Attendant. As this involves no financial liability on the part of government or the institute and because this is already in vogue in a sister department of Government of India, it is proposed that the

request be entertained and all Multi Skilled Attendants of the institute may, henceforth, be re-designated as Multi Skilled Employees.

BOARD OF GOVERNORS MAY CONSIDER AND APPROVE THE PROPOSAL.

ITEM No. B.15.4.12TO CONSIDER AND APPROVE APPOINTMENT OF TWO DEANS (ACADEMIC AND ADMINISTRATION).

Presently all the administrative and academic issues are brought directly to the level of Director which is not a healthy practice. It is, therefore, proposed that two senior most Professors of the institute may be appointed as Dean (Academic) and Dean (Administration) with some special pay, if that is deemed fit. No additional post is being sought for. This arrangement will improve the functioning efficiency of the Institute
