The comments on the issue regarding appeal of Shri KL Singla, Senior Administrative Officer were presented by Dr N Sathyamurthy at the time of meeting. Dr Sathyamurthy conveyed that the decision of the Board of Governors regarding imposing a penalty of censure on Shri KL Singla was conveyed by Dr KM Rastogi, Ex Director Incharge NITTTR Chandigarh in his capacity as a Member Secretary of the Board of Governors(not as an individual) vide letter dated December 29, 2011. After going through the comments the Board members expressed that the case may be considered as closed and the same may be conveyed to Shri KL Singla, Ex Senior Administrative Officer

TO CONSIDER THE INTER-SE-SENIORITY OF CAS PROMOTED FACULTY AND OPENLY SELECTED FACULTY

The report of the Committee was submitted at the time of meeting. As per the report, the Committee has recommended two separate seniority lists, one for the faculty recruited directly and other for the faculty promoted under Career Advancement Scheme be prepared in the institute. This will be applicable to all the cases in the past. However for future cases institute may prepare a proposal based on NIT/UGC guidelines and prepare a common seniority list.

The Board of Governors approved the recommendations of the above committee and advised the institute to do the needful as per the recommendations of the committee. However it advised the institute that for merging the seniority lists of the past cases, as suggested by the Ministry, institute may take legal opinion and then the issue be brought before the newly constituted NITTTR Council.

TO CONSIDER AND APPROVE THE MINUTES OF THE 26TH MEETING OF FINANCE COMMITTEE HELD ON 01.10.2013

ITEM NO.B.28.4.2 TO CONSIDER INITIAL TENURE OF DEMAND FOR A PERIOD OF THREE YEARS IN THE FIRST INSTANCE AND FURTHER EXTENDABLE FOR A PERIOD OF THREE YEARS

The Board of Governors approved that the tenure of the Deans will be of three years duration at a stretch instead of the earlier proposed of three years consisting of one year in the first instance and extendable for a further period of two years depending upon the assessment of work undertaken during the term of the placement. It also pointed out there will be no extension beyond the period of three years.

ITEM NO.B.28.4.3 TO CONSIDER THE STATUS OF FACULTY RECRUITED DIRECTLY AND PROMOTED UNDER CAREER ADVANCEMENT SCHEME

After detailed deliberations the Committee approved the proposal of the institute which is as under:

(i) The constitution of the Selection Committee(under Career Advancement Scheme/Direct recruitment) should be same as approved by the Board of Governors vide Item No.B.27.5.7 of 27th meeting held on 26:04:2013 which are based on AICTE guidelines.

- (ii) There should no distinction between faculty recruited against vacant positions(directly recruited) and those promoted under Career Advancement Scheme and a common seniority list be prepared in future. Inter-se-seniority amongst the teachers viz directly recruited and promoted through CAS shall be determined with reference to the date of joining and that for the teachers promoted under CAS should be with reference to the latest date of eligibility(as per the UGC guidelines) for the CAS meeting in which they become successful.
- (iii) Appointment letter both for the faculty directly recruited and under Career advancement scheme should be similar.
- (iv) All Professors irrespective of the mode of selection should start at the basic pay of Rs.43000/- and AGP of Rs. 10000/-

ITEM NO.B.28.4.4 TO CONSIDER THE REQUEST OF MRS LINI MATHEW FOR RESTORATION OF INCREMENT.

The Board of Governors did not agree with the request of Mrs Lini Mathew for restoration of increments.



TO CONSIDER FURTHER EXTENSION AS PROFESSOR(RE-EMPLOYED BEYOND THE AGE OF SUPERANNUATION) BEYOND AUGUST 22, 2013

The Board of Governors approved the extension as Professor(re-employed beyond the age of superannuation) of Prof YK Anand for a further period of one year on the same terms and conditions as approved earlier. The Committee further advised the institute to fill up the vacant posts by advertising the same at the earliest.

ITEM NO.B.28.4.6 TO CONSIDER THE STATUS OF Ph.D OF MRS POONAM SYAL, ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR

In compliance to the decision of the Board of Governors in its 27th meeting(vide item No.B.27.5.5) held on 26.04.2013, a show cause notice was issued to Mrs Poonam Syal vide letter No.NITTTR/Admn/E-1/373 dated 3.7.2013 asking her to explain " why you should not be reverted back to the post of lecturer(now Assistant Professor) for not completing Ph.D within the prescribed time limit and why your case for promotion to the next higher position under career advancement scheme should not be considered after three years period from the date of completion of your Ph.D".

Mrs Poonam Syal submitted her reply to the show cause notice on 24.07.2013. Mrs Poonam Syal has also informed that she has completed the Ph.D work and submitted the thesis to Punjab University, Chandigarh on 19.06.2013. As the Ph.D degree of Mrs. Poonam Syal is not yet awarded, the Board of Governors decided to take the decision on the issue only after the award of Ph.D degree to Mrs. Poonam Syal.
