The major initiatives include a) MoUs signed with ABB (ASEA Brown Boveri), Bangalore for sponsoring ME and Ph.D. scholars of NITTTR Chandigarh; b) students of ME programmes have been placed in industry and institutions of higher learning (MNIT, Jaipur) for their project/thesis work and encourage them to take up live problems, c) in collaboration with Skippers Electricals India Ltd., the institute has designed curriculum for their academy in Nigeria and trained six teachers in the area of electrical engineering; d) a 30-point programme has been launched to improve the quality of resources, facilities, programmes and activities of the institute.

The members of the Academic Council applauded the efforts of the Director and faculty of the Institute in achieving the targets and objectives of the Institute during 2014-15.

Prof. MM Malhotra had certain observations and suggested that: a) M.Tech Engineering Education programme needs to be revived with a different nomenclature, i.e., Master of Engineering Education (Administration and Management) to train people managing institutions/departments, staff development/ curriculum development/examination etc.;
