Prof. P.K. Tulsi, Member Secretary, Academic Council extended welcome to the honourable members of the 19th meeting of the Academic Council. Dr. MP Poonia, Director apprised the members regarding the purpose of the meeting and the preparation started for Golden Jubilee Year of the institute. He stated that a special meeting will be organized to finalize the programmes and activities to be undertaken during the Jubilee year. He highlighted the initiatives undertaken by Civil Engineering Department to offer a collaborative programme with industry on Project Management, Curriculum Development Department for developing outcome based curricula and aligning the curricula with National Skill Qualifications Framework as well as the dates finalized by the three departments for the visit of Accreditation Committee.

Item No. A 19.1 To confirm the minutes of the Eighteenth meeting of the Academic Council held on 08.05.2015

The minutes of the Eighteenth meeting of the Academic Council held on 08.05.2015 were confirmed as recorded.

Item No. A. 19.2 To note the Action taken on the decisions made in the Eighteenth meeting of the Academic Council held on 08.05.2015

The members were apprised of the actions taken on various items of the 18th meeting of the Academic Council as per the recommendations/suggestions of the members.

Item No. A. 19.3 To report on the Achievements of the institute for the period from April, 2015 to March, 2016

The achievements of the institute with respect to admission in long-term programmes, short –term programmes offered through contact mode and ICT mode, student training, workshop and seminars, curriculum design and development, instructional material development, research & development and extension & consultancy for the period April 2015 to March, 2016 were presented by the Member Secretary. The member appreciated the efforts put in by the Director and the faculty and staff members of the institute.

Dr. M.P. Poonia requested the members to propose strategies for increasing the intake to the various ME (Modular) programmes of the institute. The members proposed that analysis for the last 3-5 years of intake and pass-outs may be undertaken and states may be encouraged to formulate a policy for sponsoring faculty for long-term programmes. A meeting with Secretaries of Technical Education may be organized to apprise them of Masters Degree Programmes offered by the institute. Industries may also be made aware of the ME programmes to attract participation from them.

Dr. M.M. Malhotra requested Dr. A.B. Gupta to share the curricula developed on the basis of outcome based education and in alignment of NSQF.

Item No. A. 19.4 To report about the Academic Calendar in respect of ME programmes (both Regular & Modular) for the session 2016-17

The members were informed of the Academic Calendar in respect of ME Programmes(both Regular & Modular) for the session 2016-17 as approved by the Vice Chancellor, Panjab University, Chandigarh.

Item No. A. 19.5 To Approve the Operational Plan of the institute for the year 2016-17

Operational Plan prepared by the institute on the basis of needs identified by the stakeholders(diploma level institutions, degree level institutions, industry and other organizations etc.) was approved by the Academic Council and recommended the same to the Board of Governors for its consideration. The members were informed that this year, fifty percent of the training programmes planned are at National Level in order to enhance cost effectiveness.

Item No.A. 19.6 To consider the proposal of starting Certificate, PG Diploma and Master in Engineering Education Courses by Education & Educational Management Department

Dr. P.K. Tulsi, Head, Education & Educational Management Department briefed the members regarding the proposal for Programme in Engineering Education submitted to MHRD and AICTE. Members agreed to the proposal in principle. However,

Professor MM Malhotra suggested that a workshop may be organized to finalize the scheme and detailed syllabi for Programme in Engineering Education. In addition, he suggested that a policy decision at the national and state level regarding compulsory certification of teaching will help in attracting faculty for the programme. The programmes should be competency based and flexible in nature and permit the faculty to earn credits for courses. On acquiring requisite number of credits, Certificate/PG Diploma/Degree can be awarded. NITTTR should create a pool of trainers who can, in turn, train other faculty members. This requires establishing focal institutions in every state. Courses at Certificate level should be job embedded and enable the participating faculty to perform the roles and responsibilities efficiently and effectively. Then focus should shift to professional development, career development and organizational development.

Dr. I.K. Bhatt suggested that in order to train large number of faculty and other modalities of offering the programme such as MOOCs may be considered.

Itom No. A. 19.7 To consider the proposal of starting a PG Diploma in Project Management by Civil Engineering Department in collaboration with Bhartiya Vidya Mandir, Kolkata and supported by M/s Simplex Infrastructures Limited

Dr. Hemant Sood, Professor & Head, Civil Engineering Department briefed the **members** about the collaborative programme, i.e., PG Diploma in Project **Management**.

Dr. Parmod Mishra from Simplex Infrastructures Limited, New Delhi informed that they had organized the programme at industry level and it has been a very satisfying experience. In reply to a question by Dr. I.K. Bhatt, he stated that courses have been finalized taking into consideration the curricula in place at various institutions of higher learning and the requirement of construction industry. Members appreciated the initiative undertaken and approved the item.

Item No. A. 19.8 To Seek Guidance and Directions from the members of the Academic Council for general improvement in the programmes and activities of the institute

Professor I.K. Bhat had certain observations and suggested: (a) Tie up with leading Industries and international universities/institutes of higher learning for faculty and student exchange programme; (b) Preparation of a short film of 15 to 20 minutes about marketing the activities of the institute; and (c) developing virtual laboratories.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
