#### V12 – DRESS MAKING – BASIC

### 1. **OBJECTIVE**

To test skill competence and finishing ability of contestants in making a skirt for a girl child.

#### 2. TASK

To cut, stitch and finish a skirt for a girl child.

#### Measurements

Waist 56 cm Length 43 cm Finished length 45 cm

(with extended piping)


### 3. SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

A sample of the skirt will be displayed. The finished garment should be similar to the sample displayed.


### 4. **MATERIALS**

- Fabric- 2 meter
- Piping material  $-\frac{1}{2}$  meter
- Needles
- Zip
- Sewing Threads
- Pair of Scissors
- Pencil
- Tailoring Chalk
- Measuring Tape
- Tailor's Square
- Pins and Thimble
- Trouser Hook
- Pasting

### 5. STITCHING INSTRUCTIONS



- Cut the placket on the left side and finish it with the help of a zip. Length of placket is 15 cm
- Finish the waist-line with waist belt. Length of belt is 63 cm, width is 4 cm.



- Finish the bottom hem-line by using true bias round piping.
- Prepare extended piping separately with the help of two bias belt. Width of plain
- Fabric bias belt is 7.5 cm and width of printed bias belt is 5 cm. Fold both bias belt length-wise and join together.
- Finish the raw edges with over-locking. Place the finished belt at the bottom of the skirt and stitch. Top stitching margin 1 cm.

### 6. WORK ENVIRONMENT

- □ Working table
- □ Chair and Stool
- □ Low working table (Chowki)

- □ Carpet
- □ Sewing Machine Motorised / Hand / Foot operated
- □ Steam Iron Light weight
- □ Ironing Table

Participants may bring their own pair of scissors, measuring tape, chalk, thimble or other tools but the tools must be presented to the convenor for approval before the contest. The organizers reserve the right of not allowing contestants to use any tool if that is considered to be giving the contestant an undue advantage.

Maximum time 4 hrs.

Assessment of the skill of the participants will be based on the final product.
