VOCATIONAL SKILLS CONTEST

V28 – SILK HAND PAINTING

1. **OBJECTIVE**

The objective is to give contestants an opportunity to demonstrate their skill and creativity in hand painting on silk.

2. **TASK**

Participants will be required to hand paint a given a silk scarf, free hand, using any technique. The contestants are not allowed to trace a pattern and may use as many colours as desired from the colours provided.

3. MATERIALS

- A scarf of 70 cms x 70 cms with pre-finished edges.
- Oil colours,
- Fabric colours,
- Frolica tubes,
- Liquid acid dyes,
- Thinner
- Linseed Oil / Turpentine Oil
- Water
- Plastic Containers

4. WORK ENVIRONMENT

The following will be provided on site :

- Work table
- Chair and a stool (adjustable stools)
- Painting frame
- Drawing pins
- Steam Iron (light weight)

- Ironing board
- Colour palate
- Duster
- Brushes

6. EQUIPMENT

 Brushes (one set) (0-12 numbers) will be made available. However, contestants may bring their own brushes.

Note Contestants may bring their own brushes as per requirement. However, no equipment which gives undue advantage over others will be permitted. Any tools and equipment brought by contestants will be shown to the convenor / judges. Stencils are not permitted.

7. **ALLOCATED TIME**

Maximum time 6 hours (in 2 sessions of 3 hrs. each).

8. **EVALUATION CRITERIA**

Assessment of the skill of the participants will be based on the final work produced.
